

## **SCHOOL REPORT (2022-23)**

The system of education at TJIS, is a blend of theory and practice in the right proportion to arrive at a comprehensive curriculum. When one looks back at the past years, there is a satisfying feeling to see clear evidence of stability and sustainability, both in scholastic and co-scholastic activities.

With the advent of 2022 -23, mega and micro events began to roll with renewed energy. The purpose of our education is to build up the child in a holistic manner, so that he becomes a fully rounded personality, developed in all aspects – mind, body, heart and will. I shall now endeavour to show that we have been trying to develop the potential of our boys and girls along these lines.

The School Report is as follows for your kind perusal:

- 1. Infrastructure:** The Jain International School, Kanpur (TJIS), governed by Shrinathji Group of Institutions (SGI), is a world-class institution spread across a campus spanning about 15 acres and four blocks. The institution’s passion for knowledge is reinforced and enhanced by state - of - the art infrastructure and best-in-class educational facilities, including technologically advanced classrooms, language, science and computer laboratories with Wi Fi connectivity and Digi Classes.

- **Day Boarding (PG - XII) - TJIS TITANS- The Geniuses**

- **Residential ( V to XII) - GURUKUL - A Home Away From Home**

The school also provides **Day Care** facilities for students of classes Play group to UKG, aboon for working parents. It truly is an educational world for everyone.

- 2. Cleanliness and Hygiene :** Round the clock cleanliness and hygiene is at the top priority of the school management. There are separate washrooms and drinking water areas for girls and boys taken care of by male and female support staff under their respective Incharges. They are renovated from time-to-time as per the convenience of the students and safety norms.
- 3. Safety and Security:** The school is under CCTV surveillance round the clock with fire extinguishers installed at reachable points. Hooter is installed for any uncalled emergencies.

Visitors are thoroughly investigated and record book maintained. The Booter is installed for emergency calls.

**4. Faculty:** The faculty for Scholastic and Non Scholastic subjects is well qualified and trained as per the norms of CBSE. They attended regular workshops as organized by the CBSE Board for virtual Classes and NEP2020. All the faculty members have completed 50 hours of training as per the norms of CBSE.

**Teachers' Training --** Along with the activities for the students a spectrum of training programs and orientation for staff was also organised from time to time to update our faculty with latest techniques. I am glad to inform that all our faculty members have completed 50 hours of mandatory training as per NEP 2020. Along with those 4 teachers Mrs Jyoti Johari, Mr Umesh Rathore, Mrs Divya Saxena and I completed 72 hours of online training sessions and are now badged as a **School Innovation Ambassador** certified by Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell.

**5. Academics :** The school follows the curriculum from Classes PG to XII as defined by the CBSE. We have two terms – April to September and October to March. The sudden outbreak of Pandemic Covid brought a momentary set-back in the education system.

But, there are always ways out to difficult situations. The school buildings were closed but the Virtual Schools were on. The academics were on and the teachers at TJIS imparted their best to their learners with all the possible means they could collect from home. With the advent of the session 2022 we reverted to our normal academic routine in school and “HAPPY DAYS” were back again. We could enjoy the twittering of our little birdies in the school campus and the campus was once again resounding with learning, fun and activity.

**6. Results:** The school has been witnessing 100% success result in CBSE AISSE Class X and AISSCE Class XII under the guidance and mentorship of their able and qualified staff.
